ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

1. The name of the corporation is Aquidneck Island Robotics, Inc.

2. The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) perpetual.

3. The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section
501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, including, establishing and promoting educational
and scientific programs and activities. This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation.

4. Provisions, if any, not inconsistent with the law, which the incorporators elect to set forth in these articles of incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:
Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provisions for payment,
of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed for one or more exempt
purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or shall be distributed
to the federal government, or a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not
so disposed shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, exclusively (see attachment)

Section 4 :

for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private person, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code.
